

Images Converter Prime

Features

Images Converter Prime made for batch conversion of multiple images, with applying following operations:

1. Rename files, with saving into current or selected folder.
2. Change file format.
3. Change image size.
4. Rotate images by 90 degrees right and left, horizontal or vertical flip.
5. Crop image with user-defined borders.
6. Add canvas border to the images.
7. Additional options: convert to grayscale, sepia, negative, night-vision effect.

Standard system requirements:

1. Single-core CPU with 1,6 GHz frequency or better.
2. Video-card NVIDIA GeForce 6600 or analogue.
3. 1 Gb RAM.
4. Monitor resolution – 1024 x 768 or higher.
5. Operational system – Windows XP SP2, Windows Wista, Windows 7.

Supported file formats:

Open files – Windows Bitmap(*.bmp), JPG Files (*.jpg, *.jpeg, *.jps), Portable Network Graphics (*.png), Compuserve GIF (*.gif), Windows Icons (*.ico), Windows Metafiles (*.wmf, *.emf), Photo Shop Image File (*.psd), Tagged Image File Format (*.tif).

Save and convert-to files – Windows Bitmap(*.bmp), JPG Files (*.jpg), Portable Network Graphics (*.png), Compuserve GIF (*.gif), Windows Metafiles (*.emf), Tagged Image File Format (*.tif).

Working with program

1. Open files for conversion in menu “Files” option “Open Image(s)” or by clicking “Open Images” button. Choose needed files in open dialog, and click “Open”. Additionally you can select other files from other folders.

You can use multiple selections in dialog box, and use files “Drag & Drop” from external programs, like Windows Explorer into Image Converter Prime main window.

2. After loading, files will be shown in file-list with their attributes (file name, file size in MB, date and time of file creation, file directory). In “Original Image(s)” window you will see selected image. You can click other files to see it’s contents.

You can delete images from se list using “Files” menu with “Delete All Items” or “Delete Selected Item” options, or click “Delete All Items” or “Delete Selected Item” buttons.

Read image’s Exif-data checking “View Exif”.

3. Choose proper converting tab and setup needed parameters.

Compare image before and after conversion by choosing “Images Compare” in “Operations” menu, or click proper button. To close comparison window select “Exit” in popup menu or press “Alt+X”.

To undo chosen conversions choose “Default” in “Operations” menu.

4. Start converting by choosing “Run” in “Operations” menu, or click “Run” button. Break operation by clicking “Cancel” button, or from “Operations” menu.
5. If you wish to change conversion parameters, make needed changes and run conversion again, as described in 4.
